

## Documents for admission to the doctoral examination

The following documents are required for the application to the doctoral examination. (documents with \* can be downloaded as a pdf):

- written application for admission to the doctoral examination with original signature \*
- the Dissertation (PhD thesis) as a typewritten manuscript (Sec. 6 para. 3) in **six copies and as a PDF-File upload to wueteams:**<http://go.uniwue.de/promhabupload> (*dissertation includes: title page according to Sec. 6 para. 3 (Appendix 1), summary in german and english language, contents/literature*)
- an updated list of published scientific work in printed form and as a **pdf-File** upload to **wueteams:** <https://go.uniwue.de/promhabupload>
- Affidavit according to an oath insurance that the applicant wrote the thesis autonomously, i.e. in particular **independently** and without help of a doctoral commercial advisory service and has not used any sources and resources other than those specified by him (one **form**)\*
- Affidavit that the applicant has not been brokered commercially the opportunity to do a doctoral project and, in particular, has not engaged a person or an organization, looking for supervisors for the preparation of dissertations against payment (one **form**)\*
- declaration that the rules of the University of Würzburg about good scientific practice have been observed (one **form**)\*
- declaration whether the dissertation was already submitted in the same or a different form in another examination subject (one **form**)\*
- name of the university lecturer who supervised the dissertation (can be included in the application) \*
- A detailed and updated CV (Curriculum Vitae; with original signature + date) with representation of the educational path and the indication of the practiced profession (sample see homepage)
- An official certificate of good conduct (Führungszeugnis) if the applicant has not been employed in the public service in the last three months (copy of the current employment contract) or is not enrolled as a student at the University of Würzburg. The certificate of good conduct must **not be older than three months**. The certificate of good conduct has to be sent directly to the *Faculty of Physics, to Mrs. Sturm-Kirchgassner, Am Hubland, 97074 Würzburg*.
